## SRT Visit 2026!

Our State Review Team Visit is occurring next week! During this time, we will have a large number of staff from State Office reviewing many areas across the homes & program areas. Here are few reminders for things they will be looking to see ...

- Is Independence being promoted during mealtime?
- Is organized Active Treatment occurring in the Homes & Program areas?
- Is LOS documentation up to date?
- Are the formula feeding bags clean, properly labeled i.e. date, time, initials, and individual's name?
- Are Privacy Screens/Curtains being used during Med Pass?
- Are staff prompting individuals to leave the immediate med pass area when not receiving medications?
- Are there molding strips missing along any of the walls? If yes, is there a work order?
- Are the walls in good repair (painted)? If no, is there a work order?
- Are there any missing or non-working light bulbs? If yes, is there a work order?
- Do all stalls have working toilet paper holders? If no, is there a work order?
- Are all the appliances clean?
- Are all appliances in good working condition? If no, is there a work order?
- Are bedrooms and living areas clean, organized and sanitary & odor free?
- Is Housekeeping being contacted immediately whenever a home needs a clean up that cannot be immediately taken care of by home staff?
- Are Water Temperature Checks being completed and documented as scheduled?
- Do all the daily schedules match the current activities for the individuals on the home?
- Are the communication devices for those who need them available?
- Are the communication devices for those who need them in good repair? If no, was Habilitation Therapy notified of the problem?
- Are staff checking for correct food texture during mealtime?
- Are staff offering regular water to individuals during mealtime.
- Do individual's and staff know how to report witnessed or suspected ANE?

## Important Gate & Vehicle Reminders

Before getting in your car to drive away, you should do a walkaround to ensure no one is behind or under it.

Always ensure your vehicle is locked with the windows rolled-up. You can leave them open 1" for ventilation if needed.

Driving a pickup? Always double-check the bed of your truck to ensure you haven't gained an extra passenger. Staff at the gate will also be performing random checks for vehicles exiting.

Please **dim your lights** when approaching the gate (coming in or leaving). This makes a huge difference for Gate Staff!
